<u>Charleston, the South Carolina</u> port city founded in 1670, is defined by its cobblestone streets, horse-drawn carriages and pastel antebellum houses, particularly in the elegant French Quarter and Battery districts. The Battery promenade and Waterfront Park both overlook Charleston Harbor, while Fort Sumter, a federal stronghold where the first shots of the Civil War rang out, lies across the water.

Hotel Information

We will be staying at the newly renovated, <u>Town & Country Inn and Suites</u> at 2008 Savannah Hwy, Charleston, SC 29407. The hotel room rate is just \$149 plus tax per night. The hotel also has many Suites of various types and rates. If you prefer a *Suite*, they are available at a discounted rate by calling MRP at the number below. The room rate does not include breakfast. Just five miles from historic downtown Charleston, this is the the closest Hotel to the area's famous gardens, plantations, golf courses and area attractions. Charleston's largest shopping mall, a grocery store, a liquor store, and restaurants are all within walking distance.

For those of you who choose to arrive early or stay late, the same room rate is offered on Thu. but if

you stay on a Fri or Sat, the rate jumps to \$209+, and is <u>based on availability</u>. Make your hotel reservations NOW to insure the best availability. You may cancel without penalty up to 72 hours in advance.

Charleston International (CHS) is the closest airport to the hotel, which is 8 miles away. The hotel does not provide a shuttle service. Uber or Lyft are the best options to get from the airport.

the Charleston City Market or have a snack as you browse.

NARRATED CHARLESTON HARBOR CRUISE & DOLPHIN WATCH Tuesday, October 1 (10:30am-2:30pm)

Enjoy the beauty and discover Charleston's fascinating history while you cruise the gentle waves of her harbor on this 90-minute cruise. Listen to the narration as you view over 75 notable American landmarks, such as Fort Sumter, the carrier USS Yorktown, Battery Point, and other sites, of the "Holy City". There will be about an hour downtown to grab a snack or browse the shops before returning to the hotel.



HISTORIC BOONE HALL PLANTATION: Wednesday, October 2 (10:00am-2:00pm)



Boone Hall, founded in 1681, is one of America's oldest working, living plantations, continuously growing crops for over 320 years. The Pantation is one of our nation's most recognized historic sites and one of the most popular tourist attractions in the Charleston area.

As you enter <u>Boone Hall</u>, you will travel down the iconic "avenue of oaks" draped in Spanish moss, as seen in countless movies. Guided tours of the Plantation home showcase what a house would have looked like in the 18th

century. Eight original slave cabins are one of the most unique features of the plantation and you will enjoy a live presentation in the Gullah Theater with your tour. The cabins have artifacts and audio exhibits that help depict what daily life was like for the slaves on the plantation. You are free to roam all the beautiful formal gardens, grounds and cabins, before returning to the hotel. There is a Café on-site.
